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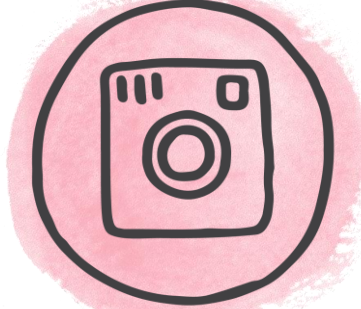
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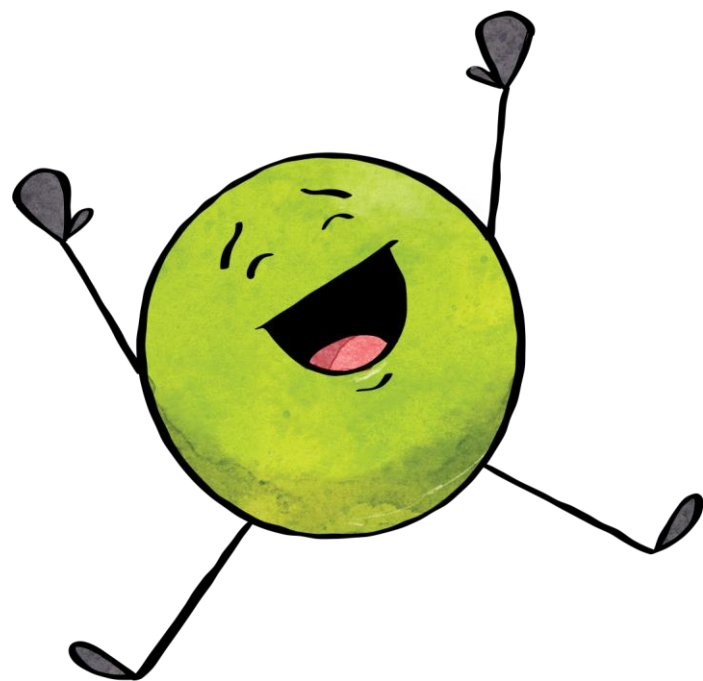
How to Use this Resource

These worksheets are perfect for World Down Syndrome Day, all you have to do is print and go! This is perfect for all grade levels since you have three worksheet options which allow differentiation.

Please make sure your students understand that their socks should be different! *I suggest printing your own copy and making an example to show your students if they are little.* 😊

These are the 3 options for these worksheets:

- Option #1: Students just draw/color their own socks.
